(Average visit 2 ½ -3 hours incl. gardens & grounds). If you are a special interest group please tell us so that we can arrange a tour with a guide with specific knowledge. For tours with Sir Hugh or Lady Stucley there will be an extra charge; please enquire. **GARDEN TOURS:** Conducted tours of the grounds and walled garden available by prior arrangement, allow 2 ½ -3 hours.
- **2. FREE PARKING** Large flat area adjacent to the house; ample parking for coaches.
- 3. SPECIAL REQUIREMENTS Please state if you have any.
- **4. DISABLED VISITORS** will be able to view most of the main reception rooms; entry to the house is up some steps as it is unsuitable for a ramp. The mediaeval basement with museum & shop, William Stukeley Exhibition, audio/visual display, tea room and disabled WC are all at ground level and accessible for wheelchair users. Please ask for full details.
- **5. SCHOOL PARTIES etc.** These must be properly supervised as many items in the Abbey are easily breakable.
- **<u>6. DOGS</u>** Welcome in the grounds on leads; Guide Dogs only in the house.
- 7. LIGHT LUNCHES AND CREAM TEAS in the Old Kitchen Tea Rooms. We would be very grateful if you could book in advance if possible. Tel 01237 440044 to book your lunches or teas.
