4. DISABLED VISITORS will be able to view most of the main reception rooms; entry to the house is up some steps as it is unsuitable for a ramp. The mediaeval basement with museum & shop, William Stukeley Exhibition, audio/visual display, tea room and disabled WC are all at ground level and accessible for wheelchair users. Please ask for full details.

5. SCHOOL PARTIES etc. These must be properly supervised as many items in the Abbey are easily breakable.

**6. DOGS** Welcome in the grounds on leads; Guide Dogs only in the house.
