

# HARTLAND ABBEY AND GARDENS

## GROUP BOOKING FORM 2023

**1. GUIDED TOURS** of the house are available by prior request and take approximately 45 minutes- 1hr. Allow extra time for the gardens, woodland walk to beach, lunch and cream tea. (Average visit 2 ½ -3 hours incl. gardens, grounds, tearoom etc). If you are a special interest group please tell us so that we can arrange a tour with a guide with specific knowledge. For tours with Sir Hugh or Lady Stucley there will be an extra charge; please enquire. **GARDEN TOURS:** Conducted tours of the grounds and walled garden available by prior arrangement (approx. 1-1/2 hrs)

**2. FREE PARKING** Large flat area adjacent to the house; ample parking for coaches.

**3. SPECIAL REQUIREMENTS** Please state if you have any.

**4. DISABLED VISITORS** Due to age of the house entry to the main reception rooms is up wide steps as it is unsuitable for a ramp. The mediaeval basement with museum & gift shop, William Stukeley Exhibition, Film exhibition, audio/visual display, tea room and disabled WC are all at ground level and accessible for wheelchair users. Please ask for full details.

**5. SCHOOL PARTIES etc.** These must be properly supervised as many items in the Abbey are easily breakable.

**6. DOGS** Welcome in the grounds on leads; Guide Dogs only in the house. **7. OUR GIFT SHOP** is normally open from 11am.

**8. LIGHT LUNCHEAS AND CREAM TEAS** in the Old Kitchen Tea Rooms. We would be very grateful if you could book in advance if possible. Tel 01237 440044 (during the season) to book your lunches or teas.

In order to make a full day out, combine HARTLAND ABBEY and its gardens and grounds with the beautiful and historic ST. NECTANS CHURCH, 'the Cathedral of North Devon', ½ mile away, enroute to HARTLAND QUAY. Guided tours with a local historian are possible by prior request. (tel. the Parish Office on 01237 441142). HARTLAND QUAY, renowned for its spectacular cliff scenery, views to Lundy Island and the scene of many past shipwrecks, is 1 mile away. THE SHIPWRECK MUSEUM at Hartland Quay is fascinating and well worth a visit too (Tel:01237 441218) or www.hartlandquay.com . There are many other attractions within easy reach; we would be delighted to help with suggestions. World renowned CLOVELLY is only 5 miles away.

HARTLAND ABBEY is accessible from M5 Junction 27 and is only 5 miles West of Clovelly, off the A39.
